

**SUMMERFIELD TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION  
COLLECTION OF STATE EDUCATION TAX FOR 2019  
RESOLUTION 2019-007**

**WHEREAS**, The State Education Tax Act, as amended by Public Act 244 of 2002, requires that beginning in 2003, the state education tax shall be collected in a summer levy by each city and township and

**WHEREAS**, The State Education Tax Act, at MCL 211.905b, enabled a township board to decline to collect the state education tax if it adopted a resolution to decline, with the written concurrence of the township treasurer, before November 1, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, The State Education Tax Act, at MCL 211.905b, enables a township board that adopted a resolution to decline to collect to subsequently adopt by a majority of the legislative body in January 2004 or any January thereafter a resolution to rescind the earlier decision to decline to collect the tax; now, therefore, be it hereby



Motion made by Michelle Provance, and seconded by Daniel Wilhelm, to adopt the foregoing ordinance (resolution).


