Clerk Provance gave the fire and police reports for May. She informed the Board and residents that the Township will have Baird and Cotter handle our F65 and Municipal

Finance Qualifying Statement again this year. She reminded residents that the Township is no longer giving out Deeds for the Cemetery. This has not been done since the 1980s. Residents are able to purchase plots in the cemetery for \$150.00 each or 4 plots for \$300.00, in the new part of the cemetery only. No one is allowed in the old section.


New Business

Supervisor Wilhelm informed residents that the Long Lake Road Project was back on. The County will be covering \$20,000.00 of the cost for new gravel and ditching. The Township will be covering \$48,000.00 of the project.

Supervisor Wilhelm reminded residents of the 10 new ORV road signs that have been placed within Township and the no trespassing signs that have been placed at the Gravel Pit.

Supervisor Wilhelm reported that the Terror Run that took place over the weekend raised \$12,000.00 for Special Olympics. In the past there was two (2) runs every year, but now there will only be one, this year. He also informed residents because of past complaints; Trail's End will not be having a Fireworks display.
