Supervisor Wilhelm called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. The Pledge was said.

Lori Martin, County Clerk, presented the Board with an update on County business. There has been a text messaging system put in place to inform defendants of fines and cost. There is also a system in place for jury questionnaires' pertaining to jury duty. All is possible through the Register of Deeds Improvement of Technology Automation Fund. She also working on a web-link to show business participation for Veterans. If there are any proposals for the Fall election deadline for submission is May 14th.

Angie Lepird, Activities Director for Summerfield Township, announced that with the help of volunteers the community is trying to revive the Bike Parade for Memorial weekend. The committee meets Thursdays at 4:00 pm for anyone that is interested in volunteering.

Nancy House, Harrison Library liaison, announced that the Library will be getting help from the Clare County Economic Development, to purchase and renovate the Surry House into the new Library. They are going to give a 10%-90% match. Great News! Also, the Library has now implemented a new policy for food and drink in the Library: No Food or Drink allowed unless supplied by the Library. /

David Hoefling, County Commissioner, presented the Board with the Commissioners report for the last meeting held. He informed the Board that there would be a meeting held the next day at 9:00 am. Supervisor Wilhelm informed him about the problem with the Road Commission; whether or not the funding for road repair had been pulled. Commissioner Hoefling will bring it to the Commissioners Meeting for it to be addressed.

The Board has taken estimates on the cost of a digital board for the township. The Board has requested an estimate from Heckman Electric for this sign. When estimate is received it will be presented for approval.

The Board will be placing no trespassing signs at the gravel pit. Residents can still take tree stumps there for disposal but no ORVs or Hunting will be allowed.




